Gennaro's best chance at a match are people of Scottish/Italian heritage, however anyone could be a match for him or one of the hundreds of other Australians waiting for a bone marrow donor. Gennaro's army are encouraging as many people as possible to join the Registry ASAP. Even if you're ineligible to give blood (for example, you've lived in the UK) if you're 18-45, you are still eligible to join the ABMDR. Can you please help?

## WILL YOU SAVE GENNARO'S LIFE?

**Gennaro has Acute Myeloid Leukaemia and needs a bone marrow donor match to survive.**

His best chance of a match are those of Scottish/ Italian heritage, but anyone could potentially be compatible. Here's how YOU can help:

- Make an appointment at [www.donateblood.com.au](http://www.donateblood.com.au) or call 13 14 95 to give blood at your local Red Cross Blood Service and join **Gs Army RED25 Group**. When you arrive, ask to join the Australian Bone Marrow Donor Registry (ABMDR).

- If you're 18- 45 years old but ineligible to donate blood, you can still join the ABMDR (even if you've resided in the UK). Call 13 14 95 and request a Bone Marrow only appointment.
